About Limited Authorities to Teach

Limited Authorities to Teach (LAT) are a special authority granted by the Board to a school, when certain conditions are met, to enable the school to employ a person who does not qualify for teacher registration, for a specific and short time frame and for a particular purpose.

A Generic Relief LAT, once granted, provides approval for the LAT holder to be employed as a relief teacher for schools in the northern or southern region of Tasmania in 2019. The Board determined to offer Generic Relief LATs in 2018 and then each year, for three years, from term 2 onwards.

The Generic Relief LAT will ONLY cover relief teaching from the date of the LAT approval until the end of the school year. All Generic Relief LAT holders will also hold current Registration to Work with Vulnerable People (RWVP) with the Department of Justice.

2019 Generic Relief LAT applications can be submitted by the individual from the **12th April 2019** onwards.

Who is eligible to apply for a Generic Relief LAT?

The eligibility criteria are listed on page 2 of the applicant guide [Applying for a Generic Relief Limited Authority to Teach](#). Briefly, student teachers in the final year of teaching degree and who have completed Professional Experience 3 will be able to apply. All applications must be made directly to the TRB, as per page 3 of the above guide.

Confirmation of the Generic Relief LAT


We recommend schools check the individual's LAT certificate, RWVP card and some other proof of identity.

Schools can access a specific TRB Online account to verify Generic Relief LATs for their region.

Log into TRB Online as an Existing User:


Username: **GenericRelief0**

Password: **relief**




Note that the 0 after **GenericRelief** in the username is the numeral zero.

Once logged in select the school's region.



You will see all the approved Generic Relief LATs for that region, sorted by the individual's surname, as well as those LAT applications underway. Note the LAT must be approved, and listed in the approved section, before the individual can be employed as a relief teacher.

The LAT ID number listed here should match that listed on the individual's certificate.
