

What happens if I don't pay my registration by the 31st Dec. 2017?

Your current cycle of registration will expire and you will no longer be registered to teach in Tasmania.

If you intend to teach in Tasmania in 2018, you will need to **reapply** for teacher registration. Your application will be processed and assessed against Board criteria for registration. You will have to pay the application fee which is an additional \$51.00 due to extra processing requirements. You will also have to wait until you have formal Board approval **before** you can legally be employed to teach.

What happens if I don't pay for my renewal by the 31st Dec. 2017?

Your current cycle of registration will expire and you will no longer be registered to teach in Tasmania.

A complete renewal application includes the online application AND payment. If you have applied online but not made a payment your application to renew is incomplete and no longer valid after your registration expires. You cannot renew or pay for an expired registration.

If you intend to teach in Tasmania in 2018, you will need to **reapply** for teacher registration. Your application will be processed and assessed against Board criteria for registration. You will have to pay the application fee which is an additional \$51.00 due to extra processing requirements. You will also have to wait until you have formal Board approval **before** you can legally be employed to teach.
